PREAMBLE :

The Mathammal Sheela Charitable Trust, Namakkal District, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to Annai Mathammal Sheela College of Education, Erumapatty Post, Namakkal-637021, Tamilnadu for M.Ed Course on 21.02.2007.

After considering the report of the visiting team as well as other relevant materials furnished by the applicant institution, had noted that the applicant institution does not fulfill the requirements and issued a notice on 22.08.2007 to the applicant institution under provision to Section 15(3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993, thereby giving an opportunity to the said applicant institution to make a written representation in this behalf.

Further, applicant institution had submitted the written representation on 19.09.2007 The said representation was considered by the Regional Committee on 147th meeting of SRC held on 13-14 November, 2007 and decided to refuse recognition.

Accordingly, order of refusal was issued vide Ir.No.15414 dated, 30.11.2007.

The applicant institution preferred appeal under Section 18 of NCTE Act, before NCTE, New Delhi. The Appellate Authority considering the appeal passed an order vide.F.No.89-366/2007 dated,20.06.2008 remanded back to SRC for re-inspection.

Accordingly, re-inspection of the institution was carried out on 31.07.2008. The VT report was considered by SRC in its 162nd meeting held on 20-21 August, 2008 and decided to seek clarification. Accordingly clarification letter was issued to the institution on 28.08.2008. The written representation submitted by the institution was considered by SRC in its 165th meeting held on 27-28 September, 2008 and decided to seek clarification. The written representation submitted by the institution was considered by SRC in its 170th meeting held on 16-17 February, 2009 and decided to issue letter of intent.

Accordingly letter of intent was issued on 04.03.2009. In reply institution has submitted the details of staff on 11.05.2009. The matter was considered by SRC in its 175th meeting of SRC held on 13-14 May, 2009 decided to issue Formal recognition order.

Hence the order.

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, Mathammal Sheela Charitable Trust, Namakkal District, Tamilnadu has submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for conducting M.Ed course with an annual intake of 25 on 21.02.2007.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, institution fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the **Higher** teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.
3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Annai Mathammal Sheela College of Education, Erumapatty Post, Namakkal-637021, Tamilnadu** for conducting **M.Ed** Course of one year duration with an annual intake of **25** students from the academic session **2009-2010** under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007 subject, to fulfillment of the following conditions:
 - I. The endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and reserve fund of Rs.3 lakhs kept in joint account with SRC, NCTE should be maintained always. Loan raising or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.
5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
- (i) Copy of the Application Form
 - (ii) Land and Building Particulars
 - (iii) Staff Profile
 - (iv) Recognition letter
 - (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.
7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.



Whereas recognition has been granted to **Annai Mathammal Sheela College of Education, Erumapatty Post, Namakkal District, Tamilnadu** for M.Ed. course from the session 2009-2010 with an intake of 25 students vide-order no 13457 dated 01.06.2009

2. AND WHEREAS NCTE Hqrs. vide their letter no.F No.49-4/2010/PT/NCTE(N&S) dated 30th July, 2010 has informed that the enhancement in the intake of one unit of M.Ed. course programme from 25 to 35 has been notified vide National Council for Teacher Education Amendment Regulation, 2010 in the Gazette of India on 26th July 2010. The amendment stipulates that the intake be increased from existing 25 to 35 students from the current session 2010-11, without creation of any additional infrastructure and instructional facilities NCTE Hqrs has directed to intimate all the institutions of each region having approved M.Ed. Programme of 25 students by issuing a letter that they may enhance it upto 35 students, accordingly.
3. NOW THEREFORE enhancement of intake of 10 seats from existing 25 to 35 is permitted to **Annai Mathammal Sheela College of Education, Erumapatty Post, Namakkal District, Tamilnadu** for M.Ed. course with effect from the session 2010-2011 till further orders without creation of any infrastructural and instructional facilities.
